History / Relevance: Traditionally during the summer months the district hires temporary seasonal employees to assist with summer grounds, paint, bus cleaning, and technology projects.

What: We are asking for approval to hire six technology positions, four ground crew positions, four paint crew positions, and three bus cleaning positions. Please see the attached requests.

Why: The summer projects completed by these employees are often difficult or impossible to complete during the school year while students are in attendance.

Where: These requests will effect Operations and Informational Services.

When: The staffing increase will be from May 27th through August 1st.

How: The Operations Director and the Director of Information services will take application. Upon review of the application and interviews of the candidates offers will be made to fill the positions.

Who: The additional staff will work under the supervision of Director of Transportation, Maintenance / Custodial Supervisor, Executive Director of Operations, and Director of Information Services.

How Much: The cost for all 19 positions is estimated at \$70,000.
