The Assignment

Required: Google Classroom Code: iab8bq

Google Classroom can be accessed via computer or by cell phone app. Reading suggestions and assignments will be posted every other Monday beginning with the first Monday in June.

The text is broken up into four chapters. The suggested reading and assignment timeline is as follows:

June:	Chapters 1 and 2 (read and respond) with online discussion questions (2)
July:	Chapters 3 and 4 (read and respond) with online discussion questions (2)
August:	Finish up any missed reading/discussion questions

The reading suggestions and assignments are to keep students on target with completing the text by the first day of school. However, each student (besides new-to-district students) will be expected to have all reading, responses (directly in book), and online discussion questions completed by the first day of school in order to be prepared for a culminating video project during the Fall semester.
