<u>Title:</u> Parents as Teachers Coordinator/Educator

Reports To: Superintendent

Supervises: Assigned students/staff members

Evaluation: As per Negotiated Agreement

Job Summary:

The primary purpose of the Parents as Teachers Coordinator/Educator is to model and educate parents in developmentally appropriate practices for young children. In addition, the Coordinator/Educator will oversee the daily operations of the PAT program and support other educators as they perform their job duties.

Qualifications:

Current Kansas teaching certificate with Master's Degree in education or family services preferred.

Performance Responsibilities:

- 1. Schedule and complete home visits with 20-25 families a minimum of 10 times per year.
- 2. Collaborate with educators to develop and offer playgroups and group meetings for birth to age 3 children a minimum of once per week.
- 3. Maintain current and complete records.
- 4. Complete local, state and national reports in a timely manner. Present these reports to the U.S.D. #261 BOE a minimum of once per year.
- 5. Screen children for potential learning problems a minimum of one time per year.
- 6. Make referrals to the proper agency when developmental problems are detected.
- 7. Provide resources for families in crisis situations.
- 8. Write and disperse a newsletter to all PAT families a minimum of 9 times per year.
- 9. Promote the PAT program to the community.
- 10. Write grants pertaining to the PAT program and submit them in a timely manner.
- 11. Schedule special speakers and activities.
- 12. Support district mission statement, goals, objectives and any and all decisions of the Board of Education.
- 13. Support the philosophy of Parents as Teachers that *All Parents Are Their Child's First, Best, and Most Important Teacher.*
- 14. Believe that all parents have strengths.
- 15. Demonstrate an ability to communicate effectively in oral and written settings.
- 16. Effectively work with and relate to people from a variety of backgrounds and parenting styles.

- 17. Maintain a comfort level in a wide variety of home settings during home visits.
- 18. Support and encourage PAT educators.
- 19. Others duties as assigned.

Physical Requirements/Environmental Conditions:

Physical and emotional ability and dexterity to perform required work and move about as needed in a fast-pace, high-intensive work environment.
