2. Observes student behavior and learning characteristics in appropriate settings as part of the assessment procedure.
3. Prepares written reports of assessment findings.
4. Presents and interprets assessment data.
5. Assists in determining individual educational needs, specifying educational goals, and recommending placement.
6. Performs designated psychological services specified in Individualized Educational Programs.
7. Other duties as assigned.
