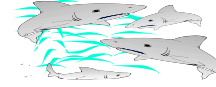
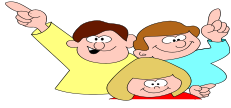

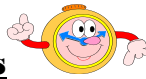

Please remember to call the office when your student will not be in school because of illness or appointments by 8:50 a.m.. Our phone number is 554-2273. Also, please have your child sign in the office if they arrive after 8:25 a.m. In the afternoon, if you have a special message for your child, please notify the office by 3:15 p.m. to assure all messages get delivered before school is let out. We will again be utilizing an attendance recognition program to help keep our attendance up. Your cooperation in this matter is greatly needed and appreciated.




Wednesday Folders-We will be sending all regular weekly communications home in **Wednesday Folders**. Please be sure to check the contents of the folder each week, sign that you have viewed them, and then return the folder promptly on Thursday. The exception to this is Pre-School which sends the folders home on Thursday. If you represent an organization which may be sending notes home with students, please be sure these notes are approved for distribution by the central office and that they arrive at school before Monday to be sent home on a Wednesday.

Safety Drills -As always, safety is **first** and foremost at Nelson School. Several special programs will be conducted during the year in this behalf. Staff and students regularly review procedures for emergency drills. Schools are required to hold monthly fire drills and periodic tornado drills. We will also practice other drills such as “Shelter in Place” and “Intruder” drills. We have already had our first fire and tornado drill for the year, and these went very well.

Volunteer Back Ground Checks-We want to remind you that we need to have **Back Ground Checks** on all volunteers that may be working in the building or will be going on field trips, etc. this year. If it has been over 2 years since submitting an application, you will need to resubmit. This is just a standard procedure and helps secure the safety of all of our Nelson Students. If you will be volunteering this year, please pick up a Back Ground Check, complete, and return this to the teacher or office promptly. Please do not wait until the day before an activity to turn them in, as processing sometimes takes several days. We would like to have as many of these as possible by mid-September. Your help in this important matter is appreciated.

FAMILY RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT-

Release of Directory Information

If you do not want Haysville USD 261 to disclose directory information from your child’s education records, you must notify the District in writing by September 13, 2017 or within two weeks of enrolling your child. If at any point in the school year, you change your mind about disclosure of information, you must follow the notification procedures listed here.

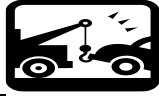

If a written notification of refusal to release directory information is not received by the District, USD 261 assumes there is no objection to the release of the directory information as designated.

Drive Procedures



■ We are very fortunate to have our drive area in the front of Nelson. If everyone follows a few basic guidelines it will help keep the kids safe, keep everyone from being ticketed, and / or the removal of vehicles. We respectfully ask your help in noting the following:

1. Please do not park in the crosswalk areas or utilize the handicap parking except for what it is intended.
2. The drive is one way—2 lanes going from the North to the South. Please follow the arrows and signs.
3. The drive is only a loading and unloading area for students (Not Parking--it is a Fire Zone.)
4. All loading or unloading should be done on the right side / building side.
5. We do have parking spaces designated as visitor parking at the very front of the building which can be used to drop off and pick up students as well.

If you have any questions about these, please ask. Thanks ahead of time for helping us keep our kids safe. We will have staff out front to give friendly reminders to help in this endeavor.
