Friday, October 21- End of 1st 9 weeks. **NO SCHOOL**. Teachers will have in service.

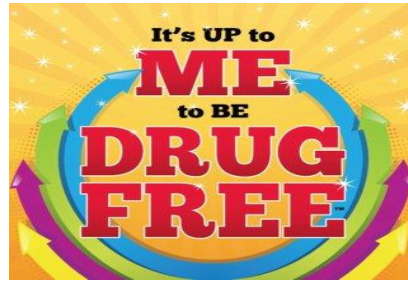

PASTRIES WITH PARENTS

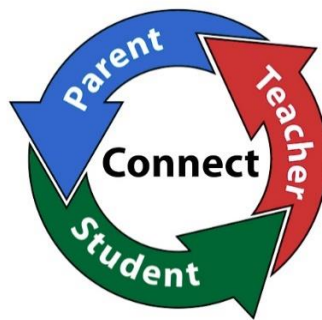
