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***What is the Star Polisher Award?*** The “Star Polisher” award program recognizes staff members, school volunteers, and school community partners who go that extra step in helping the school district and its students to succeed. During the school year, the Haysville Board of Education presents the “Star Polisher” award to a selected number of recipients based on nominations received from the staff and community. Each award recipient is nominated by a district staff member, patron, or site where their efforts are most profoundly felt. This award recognizes persons for (1) outstanding and /or lengthy service to students and the school district, or (2) outstanding service to the community, reflecting credit upon the school district.

**Staff members, students, parents, volunteers and school patrons are encouraged to make nominations.**
