WHAT WILL WE SEE?

From year to year there is some fluctuation on the sites we visit because we don't always know where we are going to be able to get appointments to. During a typical trip we will travel to Jamestown, Virginia touring the sites of our early settlement. The next morning we will go to Williamsburg, VA. It is a mile long town that has been restored and reenacts the late 1700's. After that we usually travel to DC and see all the major monuments, memorials, museums, capital building and as many of the major sites as we can fit in.

WHAT IS THE COST?

The total price of the trip also fluctuates from year to year and can range from \$2100.00 to \$2600.00. It is for an "all inclusive" trip to Jamestown, Williamsburg and Washington, D.C. Airfare, hotels, three meals a day, all entry fees, a bus coach, and a guide are the major things included in the pricing. Students would only need money for "extra" things such as souvenirs, extra snacks, a bottle of water, etc. In theory, the student could leave for the trip without a penny in their pocket and be fine. We do 3 or 4 fundraisers during the year that can help with the cost. However, there is NO WAY a student can raise the entire amount on fundraising.
