

Dates	Session I: May 26 – June 25 Session II: June 29 – July 30
Days	Classes will be held Monday through Thursday. (No class on July 2.)
Times	Morning block: 8:00 - 11:00 Afternoon block: 11:30 - 2:30
Location	Campus High School Library – Enter on East side between gymnasium and H-Building.
Enrollment	Begins March 23
Application	Application is on reverse side.
Tuition & Fees	\$150 per half credit (\$25 refundable if completed by close of the 15 th day of the session). \$40 (per class) enrollment fee for students not residing in USD 261. \$25 (per class) discounted tuition for students on free or reduced lunch program.
Focus	Completion of course objectives for students who failed to satisfactorily complete a required core course. Students must complete the final exam for the course with a minimum score of 70%.
Course Offerings	All classes in English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, and ACT/SAT Prep will be offered through Virtual Prescriptive Learning. Elective classes are available upon request.
Course Load	Students may only carry two classes at a time.
Special Education	Students with disabilities will be provided support via a special education teacher or paraprofessional, depending upon need.
Attendance	Students are required to attend one block per day for the entire session. Students who miss more than three blocks will be dismissed. Students who complete their coursework by the close of the fifteenth day of the session are eligible for a \$25 refund. Students who require additional time will be allotted one additional calendar week. All courses not completed within one week of the end of a session will result in a failing grade.
Refunds	There will be no refunds.
Behavior	Students who are disruptive or otherwise detrimental to the learning environment will be allowed a maximum of one referral prior to dismissal for the session. Students violating the district's computer use policy will be removed immediately.
Dress	Dress should be appropriate to the situation and in good taste.
Parking	Students shall park in marked spaces in the east parking lot.
